The credit is nonrefundable, so the credit amount you receive can't exceed the amount you owe in tax. You can carry forward any excess unused credit, though, and apply it to reduce the tax you owe in ...

The solar tax credit is a powerful 30 % incentive, but it only offsets taxes you actually owe. Unused amounts roll forward until they're gone, so plan for multi-year use if your tax bill is low.

It's a nonrefundable credit, which means it can bring your tax bill down to zero but won't generate a refund on its own. If the credit is bigger than what you owe this year, the unused portion...
