To power cycle your base station, unplug the power adapter from the outlet, wait two minutes, and reconnect the power adapter to the outlet. The base station takes one to two minutes to start. When ...

In this video, we will walk you through the entire process, from initial setup to reconnecting your device and troubleshooting any issues that may arise.

When troubleshooting your system, there may come a time when you need to reset your Base Station to clear out any errors. You'll need to be able to access the bottom of the Base Station to complete ...

Connected both Ethernet cables successfully to other devices. Eventually I decided to restore to defaults the base station. I used a paper clip to hold down the reset button for a bit over 10 ...

Sometimes rebooting the base stations after you do this might be needed. But you shouldn't have to do a full reset, and re-onboard the base stations and cameras.

Reconnect the Power Source: Plug the power back in to restart the base station. Wait for Initialization: Allow the base station a few minutes to initialize before confirming a successful reset.

Press and hold the "Connect" button for 2 seconds. The registration light (top light with the handset symbol) will flash green. It will show the mac address of the base. Click OK. It will ask for the PIN. By ...
