To strengthen battery energy storage safety management, manufacturers now conduct large-scale fire testing (LSFT) to provide evidence when assessing the risks and support regulatory approvals.

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A new addition to both NFPA-1 Chapter 52 and IFC Section 1206 imposes a restriction prohibiting a battery installation more than 75 feet above street level fire department vehicle access.
